4-H Opportunity Scholarship

The Texas 4-H and Youth Development Program Opportunity Scholarships are awarded each year to applicants based on their 4-H experiences, academic records and financial needs. Approximately 170 scholarships will be awarded in the 2011 Opportunity Scholarship Program ranging in amount for individual scholarships from \$1,150 - \$15,000. Each 4-H member that is awarded a scholarship will receive a minimum of \$1,500. (Applicants must be **seniors** in high school to apply).
