

Upper Sabine Cow/Calf Clinic Set for Friday, March 28th

The Upper Sabine Cow-Calf Clinic is scheduled for Friday, March 28th at Van Zandt County Farm Bureau located on 281 Highway 243 in Canton, Texas 75103.

Registration will begin at 8:00 am and the program will begin at 9:00 am. Our first topic will be "Agricultural Leases: What you need to know"- it will be presented by Tiffany Dowell, Assistant Professor and Extension Specialist.

Next on the program is Dr. Monte Rouquette, Regents Fellow and Professor of Forage Physiology, Texas AgriLife Extension Service in Overton. Dr. Rouquette will be talking about "Management strategies to offset increasing pasture cost for cows and calves".

After one of our famous Western Steak sandwiches, Dr. Tim Eberhart, DVM from Canton Animal Clinic, will be discussing "Beef Herd – Health Management/Parasite Control".

Dr. Jason Banta, Assistant Professor and Beef Cattle Specialist from Texas AgriLife Extension Service in Overton will then discuss two topics "Mineral Supplementation" and "Chemicals and Hormones: They're Everywhere".

Registration is \$20.00 per person and includes lunch, refreshments and a copy of the clinic proceedings. We do ask that you please RSVP to the County Extension office of Kaufman, Rains, Rockwall or Van Zandt no later than 4:00 pm - March 24th to guarantee lunch reservations.
