Rains County Junior Livestock Show

The 2019 Rains County Fair will be held from September 10-14, 2019.

If you have not filled out the Exhibitor Sign-Up Sheets mailed to you, you will need to turn them in immediately! They are due on April 5, 2019.

Tag-in for steers will be on Sunday, April 14 from 2:00 P.M. - 3:00 P.M. at Mike Willis' Farm. Tag-in for pigs and lambs will be held on Saturday, June 8th from 8:00 A.M. - 10:00 A.M. at the Rains County Fairgrounds.

Major Steer Show & State Fair of Texas Tags

LAST CALL - Major Steer Show AND State Fair of Texas (Swine, Lamb and Goat) Tag Orders are due no later than **April 5th** with \$15.00 payment to the Extension Office.

4-H Horse Validation Process - May 1 Deadline

May 1st has and still continues to be the deadline for a 4-H'er to certify a horse.

Horses not validated on or before May 1st are **INELIGIBLE** for District and State 4-H Horse Shows!

Heifer Validation

As most of you are aware, we began heifer validation for any heifer that you might take to any major show in Texas. We will validate heifers twice per year; once in the Fall and once in the Spring. However, if a heifer is validated once, then they will not have to go through the process again. The spring validations must be completed by the end of June. Validation date will be announced later. Original registration papers will be uploaded to a database by the Validation Committee. Please e-mail scanned originals of Beef Heifer papers to Stephen Gowin by **June 3, 2019** or bring original papers to the office by then for us to scan. Once the heifer is purchased, you must register the animal **immediately** in order to have the papers on hand by the end of June. The cost of validation is **\$15.00** per heifer. Please let Stephen know how many possible heifers you will have so he can order enough validation materials.
